PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

- The purposes of this Society shall be charitable and educational and include the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Revenue Law);
- To promote, encourage, or foster any athletic, charitable, benevolent purpose or activity;
- To promote, encourage, or foster civic or patriotic activity except that which it may deem necessary or proper for the purpose of promoting anti-discrimination conduct.
- To promote or encourage any educational, social or literary purpose or activity;
- To promote or encourage the study, understanding or preservation of ethnic identities and traditions, especially that of the Italian-American heritage;
- To promote or encourage the establishment of a facility or museum to effectuate the purposes set forth above.

MEMBERSHIP

- The American Italian Cultural Society is a family organization for all people-young and old, male and female.

BOARD MEMBERS

The Board of Directors shall consist of nine elected members from the following age classifications:

- Three (3) active members no less than eighteen (18) and no greater than forty (40) years.
- Three (3) active members no less than forty-one (41) and no greater than sixty (60) years.
- Three active members no less than sixty-one (61) years of age.

GOALS

The goal of the American Italian Cultural Society is to be a family-oriented organization that will attract and appeal to individuals in every age group, while encouraging a spirit of love and fraternity among its members. Numerous events throughout the year include dances, spaghetti dinners, bunco nights, card games, and bocci ball tournaments. Language classes and cultural events including guest speakers are also offered.

FACILITIES

The American Italian Cultural Society has a building located at 1918 Donmaur Drive in Crest Hill. The building has kitchen and bar facilities, a multi-purpose hall, bathrooms, an office, and indoor and outdoor bocci ball courts. The hall is available for rental to members and non-members. Hours of operation are posted at the bar, and are Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday as scheduled.
